



REUNITED DOG CHECKLIST

Once your lost pet has been located, it is important to make updates to any post of notifications that you have made and need to ensure that your pet is ok.

- Take your pet to the vet to be examined.
- Remove all signs and flyers that you have posted on streets and businesses.
- Delete/Update the **TOP** of online/web postings such as...
 - Lost Dogs of WI: <http://www.helpinglostpets.com>
 - Pawboost: <http://www.pawboost.com>
 - Nextdoor.com: <https://nextdoor.com> (download app to phone)
 - Facebook lost dog pages for your area (i.e., Missing Pets of Green Bay, Missing Pets of 920, etc.)
- Contact any local agencies that were notified of your lost dog.
- Purchase a good fitting harness for walking.
- Use a slip collar, such as a martingale and slip leash for an extra safety measure and control of your pet.
- Use 2 leashes for more control.
- Make sure they are wearing a collar with ID, rabies and microchip tags at all times.
- Make sure your dog gets microchipped.
- Consider looking into getting GPS collar such as Whistle, Fi or Link AKC.
