

The Drone Pilot would support aerial searches for lost dog cases. Often, this will be for high-risk emergency cases due to age, health and dog safety, such as dragging a leash. Pilot may be asked to support other lost dog cases to help expedite reuniting the lost dog with its family.

MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- The drone pilot may be called at a moment's notice to search for a dog in danger.
- The Mavic 3 Thermal Enterprise drone will be shared among licensed GTH pilots and will be registered and insured by GTH.
- Whether a case is appropriate for a drone search will be determined by the team's drone pilot coordinator, the case manager and/or board members.
- When a case requires a drone search, the pilot will be contacted via phone call, text message or Facebook Messenger.
- The case manager (or other designated team member) will be on site to provide input to the drone pilot, help identify the search area and/or appropriately respond if the dog is found by drone.

REQUIRED SKILLS

- FAA Part 107 remote operator certified.
- Experience with a thermal drone is a plus.
- Familiarity with Google applications such as Google Maps.
- Familiarity with UAS piloting apps.
- Flexible schedule to deploy on an emergency basis.
- Willingness to respond to cases withing one hour of pilot's home.

VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT

- Strict adherence to client and team confidentiality.
- Have an active Facebook account (for internal Get Toby Home group communication).
- Team player that builds strong relationships with team members and the community.
- Able to attend annual meeting and support Get Toby Home at public events.
